AAPC is recognized as a professional level industry standard. Textbook, AAPC membership, online practice exams, and certification exam fee are included in tuition. Coding books are required for the course and are provided by the student.

Prerequisite: Anatomy and Physiology and Medical Terminology. Prior coding experience is recommended.
