The first year of related instruction includes the Building Construction Core – Laborer and Construction Laborer I courses. The final course of the program, which is offered in the second year, is Construction Laborer II. Individuals who complete both years of the program, including the associated OJT, are eligible to earn a nationally recognized journeyperson credential.
