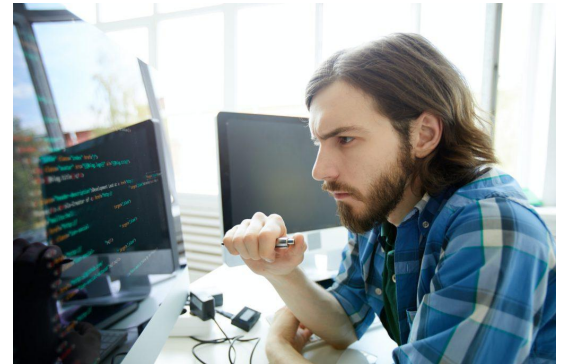

The Information Technology Fundamentals (ITF) pre-apprentice program is designed for students and career changers who are interested in Information Technology, but have limited technical knowledge of computing systems, determine if a career in IT is right for them.

ITF provides a balance of self-paced, and instructor facilitated learning. Participants explore foundational concepts related to computer hardware and software, networking, databases, programming, information systems, and data security and perform real-world tasks associated with various IT fields.

Participants are prepared for the CompTIA ITF certification, which is completed at the end of the course.
